

251 Conservative Political Influencers Call for Urgent Priorities to be Set for 87th Legislative Special Session(s)

June 28, 2021

The Honorable Greg Abbott, Governor of Texas

Governor Abbott:

When it comes to getting their priorities passed in the Texas Legislature, the people of Texas deserve better!

For several years, you have routinely heard from this statewide Coalition of conservative influencers. Since you were elected Governor, before each legislative session we have clearly communicated to you our legislative priorities, which have been overwhelmingly supported by Republican Primary voters in the form of ballot propositions. We also contact you during the legislative sessions with specific policy requests related to our stated priorities and subsequently send post-session requests to you to work with Republican majorities in the Texas House and Senate to complete unfinished business important to the conservative base of the Republican Party. *Since these matters are clearly found in the Republican Party of Texas Platform, nobody on your official staff or in your stable of political consultants can truthfully label these issues as "fringe" ideas for which nobody cares!*

In addition, your office receives thousands of calls, emails, and social media contacts from our Coalition organizations; therefore, the obvious disconnect between you as the Republican Governor of Texas and the most active conservative groups in Texas is not due to a lack of communication on our part.

Once again, we ask you to give very serious consideration to the long-term harm to Texans – to Life and Liberty – if the following failed legislative priorities from the 87^{th} Session go unremedied.















Republican Party of Texas Priorities

- Election Integrity Our Republican-controlled State Legislature has failed the last three sessions to pass election integrity measures to protect every legal vote. This is disgraceful and unacceptable! 94.82% of 2018 TX GOP Primary voters and 98.46% of 2020 TX GOP Primary voters supported.
- 2. **Religious Freedom** (prohibit biological males from participating in biological women's sports)
- 3. Ban Gender Modification stopping sex change surgical/chemical butchery of children. 94.65% of 2020 TX GOP Primary voters supported.
- 4. Abolish Abortion. 68.19% of 2018 TX GOP Primary voters supported.
- 5. Ban Taxpayer Funded Lobbying. 94.3% of 2020 TX GOP Primary voters supported.
- Monument Protection, especially the Alamo and the Cenotaph. 97.82% of 2020 TX GOP Primary voters supported.
- School Choice educational freedom for all. 78.67% of 2018 TX GOP Primary voters supported.
- 8. Restore the Texas Legislature's Constitutional role as a check and balance on the Executive Branch during declared emergencies. *The Texas Disaster Act of 1975 must be revised to properly limit its scope and conform its provisions to the Texas Constitution.*

Additional Urgent Priorities Necessary to Protect the Life, Liberty, and Property of Texans

- 9. Ensure Texas Electric Grid Security and Reliability. Our grid is neither secure nor reliable an unacceptable vulnerability for Texans.
- 10. Correct flawed CRT legislation passed in the 87th Session. Enact a complete ban on the teaching and promotion of Critical Race Theory in all public schools, public charter schools, publicly funded institutions of higher education, and all state agencies, including the Texas Military Forces. As punishment for documented violations of the ban in public education, reduce state school funding/freeze the local property tax share of funding.
- 11. Gain Operational Control of the Texas Border with Mexico. It is time to stop participating in the federal government's "catch and release" program. It is time for you as Governor to take bold steps to protect the lives and property of Texans by gaining operational control of the Texas border. This will mean a showdown with the occupiers in DC a fight most certainly worth engaging. In the meantime, plenty could be done to stop the magnets that attract illegal border crossers starting with sanctuary businesses and industries. Enforcing labor laws already on the books is not an unfunded mandate on business it is enforcement of the rule of law.
- *12.* Send Texans needed Property Tax Relief. In early May, State Comptroller Glenn Hegar revised revenue estimates for the state by \$3.12 billion. *Every penny should go directly to property tax relief for Texans.*
- 13. Ban employee and student COVID-19 "vaccine" mandates to protect Texans' right to work and to freely associate. No Texan should be forced to choose between feeding their family and taking an untested, liability free injection like the COVID-19 shots. Vaccine passports violate the Free Exercise Clause of the First Amendment because **the right of conscience** is integral to that clause of the First Amendment. Vaccine Passport laws also

violate the Due Process Clauses of the Fifth and Fourteenth Amendments by limiting the free movement and free association of individuals. *Individuals cannot be deprived of these constitutional rights unless individuals are tried in a court of law and found guilty by a jury.*

Governor Abbott, Texas is at a pivotal, critical moment in history. Texas Republican leaders should be bullish on leading the nation in bold, Texasstyle liberty. Session after session, squandered opportunities to lead on liberty push us further away from the Texas we were meant to be.

You have another chance to change the failures of the past. We appeal to you to do so by calling as many special sessions as necessary to protect children, our votes, our lives, liberty, and property. *The time for delivering results is now!*


